### L'Albero dei Gelati

An authentic Italian gelateria opened last Thursday in Park Slope. A Lombardi-based mini chain, [L'Albero dei Gelati](#), doesn't feel mass produced at all. The warm interior space with its exposed brick walls is adorned with children's drawings, while the backyard seating area is a lovely garden. You are invited to linger and of course, to keep eating like all good Italians or Brooklynites. The gelato is made onsite from organic and seasonal ingredients. Traditional varieties such as straciatella, raspberry, peach, coffee, and pistachio are served alongside unorthodox flavors like licorice, yellow bell pepper, and blue cheese. Much more than just gelato, an extensive menu of baked goods is also made onsite including focaccia for sandwiches, tiramisu, and specialty cookies. Panini and frittatas as well as other cheese and salumi are savory options. Wine and beer are served in addition to stellar espresso and cappuccino to wash down all that biscotti!
